WORK EXPERIENCE

- 2002-Present Currently, I am serving as the preacher for the Cedar Grove church of Christ. In addition to the regular preaching duties, I currently produce a weekday radio program, am involved in VBS program and work with staff and elders. Operate a professional website, www.paher.org, and serve as a Camp Wiregrass Christian Youth Camp Director.
- 2001-2002 I served as pulpit minister for the Central church of Christ on a full-time basis. This work engaged me in all aspects of a gospel preacher: preaching, teaching, visiting, evangelism, personal Bible study, etc.
- 2000-2001 Upon graduation from ETSPM, the Richmond church of Christ hired me to serve as an intern working alongside the preacher and elders and learning their relationship to church work with emphasis on application of my training.
- 1999 While enrolled at ETSPM, I served the Central church of Christ in Sweetwater, TN in the manner of song leading, Bible class teaching, and occasional preaching, which gave me hands on experience.
- 1999 During the five-week summer break at ETSPM, I served as an intern at the Richmond church of Christ. This work helped me to receive some practical experience on how a large congregation functions biblically. Programs that I worked with were education (all ages, especially Lads to Leaders), evangelism, benevolence, family groups, fellowship, facilities maintenance, communication services, computer services, audio-visual services, membership involvement, etc.
- 1998-2000 While enrolled in school, I received opportunities to preach at area congregations two and three Sundays every month. These appointments gave me practical experience in sermon preparation and delivery.
- 1996-1997 Worked for McDonald's Corporation in Kentucky as a manager, which helped me to work with people from many different backgrounds. This experience has helped to equip me with knowledge of organization skills, leadership abilities, problem-solving with people, empowering people to share responsibilities, working alongside subordinates and bosses sharing and executing ideas and plans, etc.
- 1994 Was selected as part of a group of twenty Americans from different states to be involved in a foreign educational exchange program in Rostov, Russia. Through this endeavor, I was able to interact with many people, adapt to the environment and experience a whole new world.
